United Press International Sen. William Proxmire (D-

Wis.) proposed a bill yesterday to prohibit the Central Intelligence Agency from engaging in illegal activity within the United States.

The bill also would pro-The bill also would pro-hibit the agency from engag-ing "in foreign covert ac-tion" abroad without the written consent of the con-gressional committees that oversee the CIA.

In a prepared speech, Proxmire said his proposed amendments to the 1947 act that created the CIA were proved necessary by Water-gate gate.

gate. "Is it far-fetched to con-template the illegal use of the FBI, CIA and the rest of the intelligence community against political opponents or any other faction within the U.S.?" he asked. "That is exactly what has been attempted...." "I have great admiration for the CIA and its direc-tors. It appears that they have resisted pressures of great intensity from the White House itself. That took a great deal of courage.

took a great deal of courage. It is for the sake of the CIA as well as the Ameri-can people that I offer this amendment."
