

Barker Files Fraud Charge Against Old Business Partner

MIAMI, June 7 (UPI)—Convicted Watergate burglar Bernard Barker has filed a civil suit in Dade County circuit court charging a former business associate with fraud and misrepresentation, it was disclosed today.

Barker, a Miami real estate man, said Miguel Sua-

rez and others persuaded him to become an officer of Biarritz Tower Inc., then fired him and transferred the firm's assets to another company.

The suit said Suarez would not let him see the books or records of either corporation. Berker asked that Biarritz be put in re-

ceivership and that he be paid \$5,000 damages.

Suarez denied the charges and said although Barker was briefly the firm's secretary, he never was a stockholder and therefore had no right to see the records.

Barker is awaiting sentencing on the Watergate burglary charges,
