Magruder Launches Consultant Business

Jeb Stuart Magruder, deputy director of the Committee for the Re-election of the President when the Watergate story broke last summer, has rented office space in downtown Washington and is launching his own management consultant business.

The firm is Management Research Service, and Magruder has described it as a "marketing and management consultant firm" with clients located mainly outside the Washington area.

H. L. Porter, former scheduling director for the re-election committee, told the Senate Watergate com-

mittee Thursday that he lied under oath at Magruder's request. He said Magruder

request. He said Magruder told him he himself had committed perjury 12 times.

Magruder has resigned from his \$36,000-a-year Commerce Department job and is now working on the inaugural committee's finel we gural committee's final report at a \$1,000 monthly salary.
