May Be Subpoenaed

Washington

The Senate's select Water-gate committee may subpoena financial records of the Democratic party and its presidential candidates.

Senator Howard H. Baker Jr. (Rep-Tenn.), the committee's vice chairman, made the proposal yesterday during questioning of Maurice H. Stans, who was President Nixon's campaign finance chairman.

Chairman Sam J. Ervin Jr. (Dem-N.C.), who had been conducting a vigorous examination of Stans, agreed that he would be willing to subpoena "any witness."

Democratic National Chairman Robert L. Strauss later said he "would welcome" an inspection of his party's financial records.
