

Extra Hearing On Watergate Is Scheduled

The Senate Watergate committee yesterday scheduled an extra day of hearings for next Monday and agreed to hold an additional hearing the following Monday if necessary.

The committee's regular schedule has been to hold hearings on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

Under current plans, hearings will be held June 18-21 and June 26-28, with a possible extra day June 25.

Testimony of witnesses has generally taken longer than scheduled. Yesterday afternoon, for example, the committee expected to begin hearing from Jeb Stuart Magruder, former deputy of the Nixon re-election campaign.

But questioning of fundraiser Maurice H. Stans continued throughout the afternoon, putting back the start of Magruder's testimony until this morning.
