

'He Ought To Quit'

KENOSHA (Wis.) — (AP)
— Resolutions calling either for the resignation or impeachment of President Nixon were overwhelmingly endorsed yesterday at the Wisconsin State Democratic convention.

Neither resolution was supported by Wisconsin's two U.S. senators, Gaylord Nelson and William Proxmire. Gov. Patrick J. Lucey's renewal of a call for Nixon to resign had brought the convention to its feet in a standing ovation during his keynote speech Friday night.

Proxmire said both resolutions were premature.
