

The Hearings To Resume

The Senate Watergate hearings are tentatively set to resume Monday with fired White House counsel John W. Dean III scheduled to begin his testimony.

There has been considerable confusion about the resumption of the hearings since the committee voted to delay them in deference to state visit of Soviet Communist party chief Leonid I. Brezhnev. But yesterday the Watergate committee indicated that the televised hearings will resume Monday morning.
