

A Fine for Vesco Funds

President Nixon's re-election finance committee was fined \$3000 yesterday for failing to report the \$200,000 cash campaign contribution from financier Robert L. Vesco.

U.S. District Judge George L. Hart Jr., levied the maximum fine after finding the committee guilty on three counts of violating the campaign disclosure law in the non-jury trial.

Attorney Kenneth L. Parkinson said he would recommend the decision be appealed.
