
3-Network Watergate Coverage

All three television networks will carry the Senate Watergate hearings Monday, at which former White House counsel John Dean will testify.

The telecasts will start at 7 a.m. on KRON (Channel 4); KPIX (Channel 5) and KGO (Channel 7). They are expected to end about 1:30 p.m., with a break expected from about 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 or 11 a.m.

The schedule will be the same for KGO-TV and KPIX on Tuesday.

A taped telecast of both days' hearings will be shown on KQED (Channel 9), starting each day at 8 p.m.

Radio broadcasts of the hearings will begin at 7 a.m. each day on KQED-FM and KPFA-FM.
