Conyers Asks House Panel On Watergate

NEW YORK, June 22 (AP)—
Rep. John Conyers (D-Minch.)
said today that the House of
Representatives should estab-
lish a committee to gather all
evidence about the Watergate
scandal and to outline the im-
peachment mechanism.

A member of the Judiciary
Committee, Conyers stressed
that he was not calling for im-
peachment, but seeking to in-
sure that the Congress is pre-
pared for that eventuality.

Only the House can sub-
poena a President, he said at a
news conference, and it has
the power, "and more impor-
tantly the responsibility, to de-
termine whether or not the
President has been guilty of
any wrongdoing.

"It is time that the House
began to face the fact that it
alone must resolve this issue
for the American people. In
saying this, I am not necesar-
ily suggesting that impeach-
ment proceedings be insti-
tuted now," he said.
