
Hotel Worker Is Sought In Threat to President

MIAMI, June 25 (AP)—
The Secret Service said today it was seeking a former Miami hotel worker with a history of mental illness for threatening the life of President Nixon.

An all-points bulletin was issued for the arrest of Kenneth Culp, who disappeared on May 25 with \$3,200 in funds from the hotel where he worked, the Secret Service said.

A week later, a spokesman said, a letter signed by Mr. Culp was found at the hotel, in which he threatened to kill his former wife, Essie, of Hazleton, Pa., a former girl friend, Cathie Wells of Orlando and President Nixon.

The spokesman said the letter was addressed to the Secret Service office in Scranton, Pa., and attached was a map of Dade County with a circle around the Florida White House on Key Biscayne.
