

Ehrlichman Going Back To Seattle

John D. Ehrlichman, President Nixon's former top domestic adviser who stepped down two months ago amid the Watergate scandal, is planning to move back to Seattle this summer, a source close to Ehrlichman said yesterday.

Ehrlichman has already made arrangements to lease his family's old house on Hunt's Point on the east side of Lake Washington, the source said and added: "He plans to be here by August 1."

Ehrlichman was a Seattle zoning lawyer before he joined Mr. Nixon's 1968 presidential campaign.
