Nixon's Daughter Looks Positively at Watergate

WASHINGTON, July 11 (AP)—Mrs. David Eisenhower said today that because of Watergate she thinks "Presidents will be more anxious to know everything that's going on."

And she said of her father, President Nixon, "I think he's trying to run everything himself now."

Mrs. Eisenhower, the former Julie Nixon, the President's younger daughter, was asked about the Watergate scandal by reporters during a White House reception for members of the National Association of Farm Broadcasters.

"Let's look at this positively," she said. "We can all learn a lot from Watergate."

Mrs. Eisenhower was asked about apparent conflicts between White House press officers and herself over whether the President had ever discussed resigning because of Watergate.

"This was something that came to mind, was discussed and dismissed. It never went beyond the informal stage," she said.
