**Wallace Criticized
On Kennedy Visit**

MONTGOMERY, Ala., July 12 (UPI) — Mail received by Gov. George C. Wallace since his July 4 appearance with Sen. Edward M. Kennedy (D-Mass.) has been mostly critical, aides said.

Wallace and Kennedy shared the platform at the spirit of America festival. Both men billed it as non-political, but party leaders said it was an indication that rifts in the Democratic Party were being patched up.

Billy Joe Camp, the governor's press secretary, said Wednesday that Wallace had received "about 200 to 300" letters from outside the state.

"We have received more unfavorable than we have favorable in reference to Kennedy coming to Alabama," Camp said.

Another aide said that only two of about 100 letters received in one day were favorable.
