

Visitor Is Identified

Washington

The White House yesterday disclosed the identity of a mystery visitor to President Nixon's Florida home during the Easter weekend. He was Washington attorney H. Chapman Rose. (21, 22 APR

Deputy Press Secretary Gerald L. Warren said Mr. Nixon had known Rose, who was undersecretary of the Treasury in the Eisenhower administration, for many years and had invited him to Key Biscayne "to obtain an outside perspective" on the Watergate scandal.

Warren provided the name, after Richard Moore, special White House counsel, told the Senate Watergate committee in its televised hearing that Mr. Nixon had met in Florida on the Easter weekend with a prominent private attorney he did not identify.
