## White House Agent Linked

White House Agent Linked To Taking of Protest Sign WASHINGTON, July 12 (AP) The Secret Service said to-day that a White House volun-teer, not one of its agents, was responsible for tearing down a protest sign during a visit to Pekin, III., last month by Presi-dent Nixon. "A photographer and numer-ous witnesses drew attention to a particular individual who allegedly tore down a citizen's protest banner," the Secret Service said in a statement. "The Secret Service, in con-junction with the White House, has identified the man in this photograph as a volunteer White House advance man, Peter C. Murphy of Eugene, Ore." A spokesman for the Secret Service said Illinois Senators Adlai E. Stevenson 3d, a Demo-crat, and Charles H. Percy, a Republican, had requested the investigation.
