Tanaka Not Concerned By White House Tapes

By White House Tapes Special to The New York Times TOKYO, July 23—Whether the White House tapes the talks in Washington next week between President Nix-on and Premier Kakuei Ta-naka will make "absolutely no difference" to Mr. Tanaka, the Premier said today. Answering a question at a meeting with American re-porters, he said "What has to be talked about between Japan and the United States will be talked about with per-fect candor, I don't care if they are televised to the Unit-ed States." The aftermath of the Wa-tergate investigation "will have absolutely no influence" on his conversations with Mr. Nixon, the Premier declared.
