

Judge Orders Disclosures

In Libel Suit by Chotiner

CONCORD, N.H., July 24 (AP)—A Federal judge ordered a Manchester Union Leader reporter today to disclose his sources for an article alleging that a former aide to President Nixon used teamster union funds for political espionage.

United States District Court Judge Edward T. Gignoux ordered the newsman, Arthur C. Egan Jr. to give the names to Murray M. Chotiner, Mr. Nixon's former aide, who is suing the newspaper and Mr. Egan for \$3-million in a libel suit. Mr. Egan was given until Aug. 17 to comply with the order.

The judge's order provides that Mr. Egan's responses would be made available only to Mr. Chotiner and his lawyers and would not be used for purposes other than the pending libel trial.
