

WASHINGTON, July 24 (UPI)—Jack Valenti said to-day that President Johnson occasionally recorded his telephone conversations with-out knowledge of the other person but that no White House ofices were bugged during the Johnson Adminis-

Mr. Valenti, a close aide to Mr. Johnson before becoming head of the Motion Picture Association, said that Mr. Johnson had "the equipment to roord phon calls, which he did selectively, particular-ly when he wanted to to re-cord a decision he had made." "But it was not auto-

made." "But it was not auto-matic," he said in an inter-view on the NBC-TV "To-day" show. "Nt had to be activated." Asked if the other person would know about the tap-ing, Mr. Valenti said, "To my knowledge, no."
