John D. Ehrlichman said yesterday that mail he and his attorney have received in the past three days is running heavily in his favor.

"Only two out of every 200 have been critical," Ehrlichman said. He said he has received about 300 letters and telegrams in all.

John J. Wilson, Ehrlichman's attorney, said he received 50 phone calls and telegrams critical of Senator

Daniel K. Inouye (Dem-Hawaii), a member of the Senate Watergate committee. After Inouye finished questioning Ehrlichman Wednesday, thinking his microphone was turned off, he turned to his aide and whispered, "What a liar."

Wilson read to reporters one telegram from Houston, Tex., saying it was a typical one. "Very impressive performance. Glad you're not knuckling under."
