

Julie Says Nixon Will Talk Soon

Julie Nixon Eisenhower said yesterday her father will speak out on Watergate "in about two weeks."

Mrs. Eisenhower, in Atlanta to honor volunteer workers at Grady Memorial Hospital, staunchly defended President Nixon's refusal to release tapes of White House conversations.

"It's well to remember that the members of the Senate and House would not want to share personal documents with my father," Mrs. Eisenhower said. "Nothing could be more personal than a tape."
