His name was also on the list of White House enemies presented to the Senate Watergate committee by former presidential counsel John W. Dean III. Last Monday Kalb said, he again found evidence that his office had been entered. However department

State Department officials said no evidence has been turned up concerning the in-cident. The newsman said nothing appeared to be missing.
