Contempt Charge Reversal Asked Convicted Watergate con-spirator G. Gordon Liddy yesterday asked the U.S. Court of Appeals to reverse a contempt citation he re-ceived for refusing to testify before a grand jury. The House Armed Serv-ices Committee voted Tues-day to seek a contempt of Congress citation against Liddy for refusing to testify before its members. Liddy has consistently re-fused to say anything about the bugging of Demcoratic headquarters... After his 'conspiracy con-viction Jan. 30, he was granted limited immunity from prosecution but re-fused to testify before the grand jury. U.S. District Judge John J. Sirica held him in contempt and im-posed a sentence running through December which he added to Liddy's six-year sentence for the bugging conviction.
