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Nixon Is 'Well' After Pneumonia

Two weeks after leaving the hospital, President Nixon is "essentially recovered" from his viral pneumonia, White House physician Walter R. Tkach said yesterday.

"He shows no signs of the illness," Tkach said in an interview. "I'd say he was totally recovered except he hasn't gained back the two pounds he lost. But I don't care if he never gains them back."

Mr. Nixon normally varies between 170 and 174 pounds. His weight on leaving the hospital was 168.

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
