

Nixon Watergate Response Likely Withing Two Weeks

CAMP DAVID, Md., Aug. 3 (UPI)—President Nixon is developing a new response on the Watergate scandal while spending the weekend at his retreat here, a White House spokesman said today.

The President's position is likely to be set forth within the next two weeks, said the deputy press secretary General L. Warren.

Mr. Warren told reporters that Mr. Nixon had not yet decided on the form or forum of his statement, or had he begun to draft it. The 10 men in the White House legal counsel's office are preparing material for him.

Mr. Nixon flew to Camp David late yesterday and is expected to return to the White House Sunday night.
