Group's Bid for I.T.T. Files WASHINGTON, Monday, Aug. 6 (AP)—Archibald Cox, the special Watergae prose-cutor, asked a Federal judge today to deny a private or-ganization's request for Gov-ernment files on the Telegraph Corporation. Mr. Cox said that releasing the documents would hinder his own investigation of I.T.T. and hamper any resulting crim-inal proceedings. His statement was made in an affidavit filed in United States District Court in Wash-ington as part of a Justice De-partment brief opposing de-mands made by the Project on Corporate Responsibility, a pri-vate watchdog group.
