Cox Calls on Judge to Deny
Group's Bid for I.T.T. Files

WASHINGTON, Monday, Aug. 6 (AP)—Archibald Cox, the special Watergate prosecutor, asked a Federal judge today to deny a private organization's request for Government files on the Telegraph Corporation.

Mr. Cox said that releasing the documents would hinder his own investigation of I.T.T. and hamper any resulting criminal proceedings.

His statement was made in an affidavit filed in United States District Court in Washington as part of a Justice Department brief opposing demands made by the Project on Corporate Responsibility, a private watchdog group.
