WASHINGTON — (AP) — The right wing Young Americans for Freedom condemned President Nixon for Watergate yesterday and demanded that he fully disclose his own role in the affair.

The YAF annual conveniton approved another resolution against legal abortion and rejected one urging elimination of jail sentences for possession and use of marijuana.

The Watergate resolution drew extensive discussion in which no speakers defended Nixon but many assailed him for allowing the incident to occur and failing to adhere to conservative principles.

"Nixon deserves what he gets. Deep six the Nix," said one delegate, arguing for an even stornger resolution of condemnation.

About 1100 delegates are attending the annual convention of the organization, which generally espouses a far right position on political issues and accuses many Republicans of being too liberal.
