

Poll Says Most Think Nixon Lying

NEW YORK — Most Americans still believe that President Nixon is not telling the complete truth about Watergate, according to a poll commissioned by Time magazine.

The telephone poll, conducted by the Daniel Yankelevich firm, showed that only 39 percent of those who heard or read about Nixon's television speech thought he was telling the full truth, Time said yesterday.

The figure increased by a negligible one percent after Nixon's press conference, the magazine said. However, after the press conference, 22 percent said they had greater confidence in Nixon than before.
