

Cox Appoints

Trial Lawyers

Washington

Special Watergate prosecutor Archibald Cox announced yesterday appointment of four trial lawyers to his investigation of illegal contributions in the 1972 presidential campaign and the secret White House "plumbers" operation.

The four were Jay S. Horowitz, 30, of Philadelphia, a former assistant U.S. attorney in New York; Frank M. Turkheimer, 33, of Madison, Wisc., associate law professor at the University of Wisconsin and a former assistant U.S. attorney in New York; Charles C. Breyer, 31, assistant district attorney of San Francisco, and John A. Sale, 29, an assistant U.S. attorney for Connecticut.
