

## Watergate Committee Gets Set

Senate investigators are preparing a confidential report on political espionage and campaign finances to be presented to the Watergate committee when the panel returns from a month-long recess next week.

The committee is expected to use the report in deciding how to proceed with its broad investigation of the 1972 presidential campaign.

Chief counsel Samuel Dash said he expects to present his staff's latest findings at an executive session with the committee's seven senators Tuesday.

The senators will decide then when to resume their hearings and how to air the second and third phases of their three-pronged probe. The first phase covered the Watergate break-in and cover-up.
