**White House Won't Say
If Ziegler Got Apology**

WASHINGTON, Sept. 4 (UPI)—The White House refused today to say whether President Nixon had apologized to White House press secretary, Ronald L. Ziegler, for shoving him during an appearance in New Orleans on Aug. 20.

However, the deputy press secretary, Gerald L. Warren, told reporters, "The President and Ron had a number of discussions following the incident."

"They have an excellent relationship," Mr. Warren said. "They understand each other fully. The matter is of no great concern to both."

Mr. Warren said discussions of the episode between Mr. Nixon and Mr. Ziegler "should remain private."
