

A Court Is Asked to Shield Birth Data on a McGovern

INDIANAPOLIS, Sept. 7 (AP) —The State Supreme Court has been asked to stop a lower court from releasing to newsmen a birth record allegedly listing a George S. McGovern as the father of an illegitimate child.

State Attorney General Theodore L. Sendak asked the state's high court yesterday to block an order for release of the document issued by Allen County Circuit Judge Herman F. Busse, after an action by The Fort Wayne News-Sentinel.

Senator George McGovern, the 1972 Democratic Presidential candidate, has denied that he fathered an illegitimate child.
