



**Douglas on Mend  
After Flu Attack**

SEATTLE, Sept. 7 (AP)—U.S. Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglas is expected to be discharged this weekend from the University of Washington hospital, officials said today.

Dr. Robert G. Petersdorf, chief physician attending the 74-year-old jurist, said Douglas is making "an uneventful recovery" from a bout of stomach flu.

In Rochester, Minn., meanwhile Chief Justice Warren E. Burger, 65, was released from Methodist Hospital after undergoing surgery for repair of a hernia. He entered the hospital Monday and was originally scheduled to be released Sunday, but was released today because of his excellent condition, his office said.

Another Supreme Court Justice, Harry A. Blackmun, was released from the Mayo Clinic today where he underwent a routine annual checkup, a hospital spokesman said.
