Probers May
Fight Over
Witness

MIAMI — The Senate Watergate Committee is expected to summon a Miami builder within several weeks to testify about what he termed a "shakdown" by top presidential campaign fund-raisers last year.

The appearances by the builder, John Priestes, who was questioned last week by a committee investigator, may be opposed by Florida Sen. Edward Gurney, a Republican member of the committee, according to a committee source.

Priestes has testified to FBI and Internal Revenue Service agents probing Federal Housing Administration corruption here that he paid more than \$170,000 in bribes to two men close to Gurney for favored treatment by the FHA.
