Inouye Tells All

On Fund Dinner

Senate Watergate committee member Senator Daniel K. Inouye (Dem-Hawaii) took a move unprecedented in state politics Saturday by revealing every contributor to his recent fund-raising dinner, and the amount each person gave.

"If I'm going to talk about campaign finances," Inouye said, "I'd better start prac-eticing what I preach."

In a huge campaign report, Inouye released the names of 745 contributors to his campaign fund-raising dinner held last month.

The full public disclosure. down to the last penny, has never before been seen in local or state politics. Inouye promised on August 16 that he would make the move, and said his decision was prompted by recent cam-paign financing scandals, including Watergate.
The "Dinner With Dan"

committee announced that after expenses of \$41,178.16 were deducted, a profit of \$113,901.84 was made.

The two largest contributors were Cecil L. Hefterl, president of Pacific Broadcasting Co., and William F. Ragan, an attorney from Potomac, Md., who gave \$5000 each.
