The Senate Watergate committee yesterday put off until tomorrow its first meeting in more than a month, delaying by one day a decision on when and how to resume the panel's public hearings.

When the seven-member committee returns from its summer recess, chief counsel Samuel Dash is to present a report on his staff's work during August and recommendations for resumptions of the hearings.

The committee is expected to reconvene its hearings early next week with testimony from former presidential counsel Charles W. Colson, Watergate conspirator E. Howard Hunt, Hunt's lawyer and two attorneys for President Nixon's re-election committee.
