Sturgis's Miami attorney El-lis Rubin, has petitioned the federal court here to order U.S. government tapes and rec-ords released for use in his defense in the Miami case.

The defendant was charged The defendant was charged on Aug. 20 with one count of burglary and two counts of il-legally transporting stolen Florida cars across the Mexi-can border. He is serving a pro-visional 40-year sentence for his participation in the June, 1972, burglary of Democratic national headquarters in Washington's Watergate com Washington's Watergate complex.

Sturgis pleaded innocent to the Miami charges in federal court here last Friday. $7 \leq \varepsilon_P$ "The Mexican thing was

really a CIA operation, and Sturgis was acting in that ca-pacity," Rubin said. "We want all the records to substantiate this. If they can't or won't be produced, the case should be dismissed."

The petition claims that the

Intelligence Agency records he says can clear him of charges of complicity in a stolen car ring. Among the tapes sought by Rubin are recordings of al-leged conversations between former White House counsel former White House counsel John W. Dean III, former CIA Director James R.
