

# Liddy to Be Arraigned on Sept. 20 in L.A.

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 14 (UPI)—The district attorney's office said Thursday that arraignment of four defendants in the case of the break-in at the office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist will be completed

Sept. 20, when G. Gordon Liddy is brought here from a federal prison in Connecticut. John D. Ehrlichman, Egil (Bud) Krogh and David Young have already pleaded innocent to charges relating to the

break-in at the Beverly Hills office during the Labor Day weekend of 1971.

Of the four defendants, only Liddy will be required to be present Sept. 20, a date previously scheduled by Superior

Court Judge James G. Kolts setting a date for trial.

Attorneys for Ehrlichman, Krogh and Young are expected to ask for severances of their cases so that their clients are tried individually.
