Call a Hoax -White House

URBANA (Ill.) — (AP) — Urbana businessman Dwight Dobbs admits the call he received from the "White House was probably a hoax," but it hasn't changed

his feelings any.
"I still believe in Dick
Nixon," Dobbs, 41, said yesterday.

Dobbs had erected a large billboard in Urbana that described his faith and support in the President. He said Nixon called him Thursday night to express thanks.

White House spokesman Gerald Warren said the

President had not-called and that it appeared to be a hoax.

The billboard, which cost Dobbs \$300, read: "I have more faith in this man than

I have in any of his accuser, especially the press."

Dobbs signed the bill-board: "Dwight Dobbs, a Proud American Citizen."
