Although the number of people who view each com-mittee member in a negative mittee member in a negative light (only fair-poor) has risen in every-case, in al-most every case the com-mittee member's positive rating (pretty 'good-excel-lent) has gone up even more. This pattern holds for Sens. Baker, Inouye, Weicker, Gurney, Talmadge and Mon-toya.

toya. The lone exceptions are Sen Ervin, the committee chairman, and Samuel Dash, the majority counsel. Criti-cism of Ervin has risen by six points while projection six points, while praise for him has gone up only one point. In the case of Dash, he has improved his posi-tive rating by two points,

but these gains are can-celed out by a two-point rise on the negative side of the ledger the ledger. Ervin has taken on parti-

san overtones when his standing is analyzed by peo-ple's politics:
