

Sen. Baker Is Having None of It

Senator Howard H. Baker Jr. (Rep-Tenn.), vice chairman of the Senate Watergate committee, said yesterday reports he has been approached to consider accepting the vice presidency are "absolutely untrue."

"They have absolutely no shred of truth about them," he said. "I know nothing about it."

Asked by newsmen if he would accept the post if it were vacant and offered to him, Baker replied, "I will make no comment whatsoever. Anything I said would be unfair."

In the past week, there has been a barrage of reports that Vice President Spiro T. Agnew would resign as a result of events growing out of a kickback scandal in his home state of Maryland.
