**Cox Staff to Investigate
Melee During a Nixon Trip**

SAN JOSE, Calif., Sept. 25 (AP)—The staff of the special Watergate prosecutor, Archibald Cox, intends to investigate activity of Presidential aides in connection with a rock and egg throwing melee that erupted when President Nixon visited here in 1970, an aide says.

A letter from a Cox assistant, Nathaniel H. Akerman, to State Senator Alfred E. Alquist, Democrat of San Jose, who requested the inquiry, was released yesterday. It said: "This office is aware of allegations arising out of the President's visit to San Jose in 1970, and it is our intention to investigate this matter to the extent it falls within the jurisdiction of this office."
