said today that the Senatal Watergate committee would recess is hearings at the endof next week when the Senate begins a two-week brest. Senator Ervin, the committee chairman, said that by then the committee should have finished its investigation of political "dirry tricks."

When the hearings resume at the end of the month, the Senator said, the committee will move into testimony on campaign financing. Today was the first day since the hearings began in May that that they have not been shown on daytime television. The result apparently affected the committee's attendance. Senator Herman E. Talmadge, Democrat of Georgia, missed the morning sension today. Senator Howard J. Gurney, Republican of Florida, skipped the afternoon testimony.
