

Nixon Seeks Relaxation At Key Biscayne Home

KEY BISCAYNE, Fla., Oct. 5 (UPI)—President Nixon sought relaxation today at his Key Biscayne vacation home, his first trip away from the

Washington area in more than a month.

With him were two of his top advisers on Watergate developments, special White House counsel J. Fred Buzhardt and speechwriter Patrick J. Buchanan. However, presidential press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler said Mr. Nixon had "nothing specific" to discuss with them but merely wanted them on hand in case he might wish to review "something" with them.

The President was expected to spend part of the weekend on Grand Cay, the Bahamas, the home of his friend, industrialist Robert H. Abplanalp.

Also with the President was his chief of staff, Alexander M. Haig Jr. Mrs. Nixon and other members of the family remained in Washington.
