Watergate Hearings Today

Washington

The Senate Watergate hearings resume today with two Nixon campaign undercover agents on the witness schedule.

Summoned to testify at the morning session is Michael W. McMinoway, who has been identified in news reports as Sedan Chair 2, an agent who infiltrated the campaign organization of Senator Hubert H. Humphrey when the Minnesota Democrat was seeking his party's presidential nomination in 1972.

Following McMinoway, the Senate committee will hear from John Buckley, another private investigator, who was reported to have infiltrated Senator Edmund S. Muskie's campaign headquarters in Washington.

Watergate conspirator E. Howard Hunt has testified that G. Gordon Liddy sent him to meet a man he knew as "Fat Jack" who turned over to Hunt "photographically stolen" documents from Muskie headquarters.

Hunt identified Buckley as "Fat Jack" and said he delivered cash to Buckley to pay for the photographs.
