San Francisco Mayor Joseph Alioto had a novel suggestion for Spiro T. Agnew's successor:

"A practical solution would be for the President to honor the succession law and name Speaker Carl Albert (Dem-Okla.) as the new Vice President.

"He would be confirmed by acclamation in the Congress; he would give the Administration three years of new unity and a fresh, bipartisan approach so necessary to reinvigorate the country's leadership in these critical years."

Alioto said that although Albert is a "personal friend," he had not discussed the suggestion with him.
