

Ervin To Answer A Subpoena

Washington

The chairman of the Senate Watergate committee said yesterday that he has been served with subpoenas to give evidence in the Vesco case trial of two former Cabinet members and that he will attempt to comply.

"I just don't believe in suppressing evidence," said Senator Sam J. Ervin Jr. (Dem-N.C.)

He said subpoenas were issued to him at the request of lawyers for former Attorney General John N. Mitchell and former Commerce Secretary Maurice H. Stans.

They are accused of perju-

ry conspiracy and obstruction of justice in connection with a secret \$200,000 cash contribution to President Nixon's re-election campaign from fugitive financier Robert L. Vesco.
