The lawyers asked U.S. District Court Judge John J. Sirica yesterday to quash the sub-poena as "unreasonable and oppressive," but they said they expected the motion to be overruled, as was an earlier effort to block renewed grand jury questioning of former White House domestic adviser

"We just want to preserve our legal position on any appeal," Strickler said. "We think that when a man is a target of a grand jury investigation, he should not be called. We think this is improper."
