Nixon Gives Rogers a Medal For Service

William P. Rogers, whose role as secretary of state was largely eclipsed by Henry A. Kissinger, received the Medal of Freedom from President Nixon yesterday for "a brilliant career of public service." public service."

The presentation was made at a White House dinner where Rogers' wife, Adele, received the Presidential Citizens' Medal for being "the nation's premiere hostess in foreign affairs."
